Given the severity or complexity of the child's support needs, a clear professional recommendation as to what educational placement type would be most appropriate to best meet the child's needs, along with a rationale for the same (**Not required for Early Intervention applications**)

And

<u>A letter from the NCSE</u> confirming that the child is known to them and that the child has the required diagnosis and recommendation for a special class for autism (Not required for Early Intervention applications)
